

What is FCS (Foundational Community Supports), and How to Get Started?

Supportive Housing services help individuals get and keep community housing. Supported Employment services help individuals with barriers to employment get and keep a job.

FCS Participants must have Medicaid. Must also have **ONE** Health need such as:

- mental health
- substance use
- need assistance with daily activities
- has had multiple caregiver
- complex physical health need

Must also have **ONE** risk factor such as:

- Chronic homelessness
- Frequent contacts with jail, inpatient hospital, and/or correctional facility
- Residential care stays
- Inability to maintain employment

Please note that FCS Services do not

include, or guarantee, financial assistance. However, case managers can assist with locating/ requesting financial assistance, and offer help with budgeting. For further questions please contact

Mason County Housing and Essential Needs (HEN) Program:

The purpose of the Housing and Essential Needs (HEN) program in Mason co. is to prevent the homelessness of and to rehouse unemployable adults and assist them with basic essential needs such as rent and utility payments or personal hygiene products.

To qualify, the applicant must have go through DSHS (Department of Social and Health Services.)

Weatherization: Energy efficiency measures are made to a home. These may include: Air sealing measures,

Weather-stripping and caulking, insulation measures to ceiling, wall, and floor areas, Related repair measures; Health and Safety Issues, Indoor air quality, Heating system repairs.
